IROM 300: Palpation Guided IROM Workshop-I:

Cancun, Mexico

- a. IROM 300 is an Intermediate-level IROM/Prolotherapy educational course & medical mission which takes place in beautiful Cancun, Mexico, designed to give each physician-learner a direct, **hands-on treatment experience with live patients.**
- b. Our host physician and Clinic Coordinator is Dr. Wajid Burad, a Cancun native and Sports Medicine Physician, who coordinates the patient recruitment, treatment, and follow-up care of all the local patients.
- c. IROM 300 is a patient based experience with live patients and complex conditions, so the physician-learner can expect to personally perform supervised, directed, palpation-guided Prolotherapy injections.
- d. There is a limited number of physician-learners admitted to IROM 300 such that the maximum student to instructor ratio is 4:1.
- e. The pre-requisites for IROM 300 are:
 - i. Be an active member of the AAOM in good standing, and
 - ii. Have taken the AAOM Annual Workshop (IROM 200), or prior participation within the last 5 years of any AAOM international workshop, or prior participation within the last 5 years of >1week of any international HHPF Prolotherapy trip.

Curriculum Fulfillment for Specialist in (IROM)

IROM 400: AAOM Advanced-II: US-guided Prolotherapy:

Cancun, Mexico

- f. The 400 course is designed for the learner who is interested in increasing the accuracy of Prolotherapy injections or preparing for more accurate placement of “more advanced” IROM procedures, such as PRP and stem cells.
- g. The physician-learner will be instructed with no more than 3:1 student to instructor ratio.
- h. Will be required to perform US-guided Prolotherapy injections under the supervision of the faculty.
- i. Course is limited to 9 physician-learners.
